John Yoo is Emanuel Heller Professor of Law at the University of California at Berkeley, a Visiting Scholar at the American Enterprise Institute, and a Visiting Fellow at the Hoover Institution, Stanford University. He is the author and editor of nine books; the latest is Striking Power: How Cyber, Robots, and Space Weapons Change the Rules for War. He is finishing a new book, Defender-in-Chief: Trump's Battles for Presidential Power, to be published by St. Martin's Press in July.

Professor Yoo has published almost 100 articles in academic journals on subjects including national security, constitutional law, international law, and the Supreme Court. He also regularly contributes to the editorial pages of *The Wall Street Journal, New York Times, Washington Post, Los Angeles Times*, and *National Review*, among others.

Professor Yoo has served in all three branches of government. He was an official in the U.S. Department of Justice, where he worked on national security and terrorism issues after the September 11 attacks. He served as general counsel of the U.S. Senate **Judiciary** Committee under Chairman Orrin Hatch of Utah. He has been a law clerk for Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas. Professor Yoo graduated from Yale Law School and summa cum laude from Harvard College.
