Kenneth Winston Starr is an American lawyer, who has served as a federal Court of Appeals judge and as solicitor general for George H. W. Bush. He is best known for heading an investigation of members of the Clinton administration that led to the impeachment of U.S. President Bill Clinton.

Starr served as the dean of the Pepperdine University School of Law. Later the president and chancellor of Baylor University in Waco, Texas, from June 2010 until May 2016, and was the Louise L. Morrison chair of constitutional law at Baylor's Law School.

In 2018, Starr released, **Contempt: A Memoir of the Clinton Investigation**. Twenty years later, he shed light on everything he couldn't say during the Clinton years, even in his carefully detailed "Starr Report" of September 1998.

Starr frequently works on death penalty cases, investigating whether or not convicted criminals belong on death row. Starr has been married to his wife, Alice Mendell, since 1970.
