



ELDORADO COUNTRY CLUB GUEST/FAMILY RULES AND DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Guest/Family Use during the Season (November, January-April)

Dining

- Unaccompanied Family are permitted to use The Grille at all times with an authorized Guest Pass. Take-out dining is available from all venues.
- Unaccompanied Guest - No use of Dining
- Accompanied family/guests may use the dining facilities without restriction.

Golf

- Accompanied Family- Tee times available after 10 am
- Unaccompanied Family - Tee times available after 3 pm with an authorized Guest Pass.
- Accompanied Guest- Tee times available after 12 pm.
A member may host one accompanied guest between 10 am and 12 pm. For example, a husband and wife may host another couple during this period.
- Unaccompanied Guest - No use of Golf.

Tee times may be made seven days in advance.

Fitness Center

- Accompanied Guests/Family may use the Sport & Fitness Center during regular Fitness Center hours.
- Unaccompanied Guests/Family may use the Sport & Fitness Center between the hours of 11 am- 3 pm, with an authorized guest pass.

Unaccompanied Guest/Family Use during the Off Season (December, May - October)

- Use of the Golf Course, Sport & Fitness Center, and dining facilities is permitted without time restriction with an authorized guest pass.

Dress Requirements

General Rules

Eldorado's guidelines for tradition, etiquette and dress require members and guests to be dressed in appropriate attire for all activities in all the common areas of the Club. Members should inform their families and guests of these guidelines for regular events, dining and private parties. Specific attire will be posted for themed events at the Club. Children aged 10 and older must comply with adult dress codes. At the direction of the Board of Directors, staff is unable to serve those who are not in compliance with the Dress Code.

At no time are the following items of apparel acceptable anywhere: tank tops, tank-style undershirts, jogging tops on men, halter tops or jogging tops for women, frayed or tattered cut-off shorts or clothing carrying inappropriate messages. Shirts and shoes are required at all times except at the pool area. Denim jeans, cargo and short shorts are not allowed anywhere. Caps, hats and visors for men and boys are not allowed in the social or dining areas. Gentlemen will remove their headwear where appropriate.

1. Dress Code Descriptions

Eldorado Casual - Slacks, collared shirts, mock turtleneck shirts and sweaters are acceptable for men and boys. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times. Skirts, slacks, sweaters and blouses are acceptable for ladies.

Eldorado Formal - Slacks, collared shirts, jackets are required, ties preferred for men. Dresses, slacks, skirts, blouses, sweaters and jackets are acceptable for women.

Black Tie - Black or white tie for men and cocktail or ball attire for ladies.

2. Golf Attire

All golfers must wear proper golf attire when playing golf or using the practice range, putting green, and chipping green. All golfers are expected to look neat, clean and presentable. Jeans, jean shorts, cargo shorts, cutoffs, tennis shorts, tee shirts, tank tops, jogging clothes, halter tops and workout clothing are not acceptable dress. The length for ladies shorts, skirts and skirts is not to exceed 4 inches above the knee. Men's shirts should be tucked in at all times. Golf shoes are mandatory and metal or spider spikes are not permitted. Junior golfers are expected to abide by these guidelines. Members and guests must use the Locker Room for changing clothes and shoes.

3. Tennis Attire

Proper tennis attire and shoes are required at all times for the courts and the facility. No cut-off shorts or workout attire or sports number shirts are allowed. Swimming, track or basketball attire is not permitted.

4. Pool and Swim Attire

All attire should be kept in good taste in the family concept of Eldorado Country Club. Swim attire is not permitted outside the pool areas. Cover-ups and shoes must be used when going to the Fitness Center from the pool area and when leaving the facility to return to another area on

the grounds. Children aged three and under, or those not potty trained, must wear swim diapers.

5. Fitness Center

All members and guests should wear proper attire for the specific activity in which they are participating: workout sessions, classes, hikes, etc. Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. Open-toed shoes, sandals or going barefoot is not allowed. No swimsuits, muscle shirts or denims are permitted. No bare midriffs will be allowed.

6. Clubhouse Dining to include the Eldorado Room, the East Dining Room, the Lounge, the Eisenhower Room, and the Patio

Golfing attire is acceptable for breakfast and lunch, meetings and casual events until 5:30 P.M. unless otherwise advertised. Tennis shorts, short shorts, cover-ups and warm-up suits are not permitted. Clubhouse dining requires Eldorado Formal attire on Friday and Saturday nights and Eldorado Casual attire on other evenings.

7. Dining in Ike's and The Grille

Eldorado Casual and "Eldorado Appropriate" golf attire is permitted at all times in Ike's. "Eldorado Appropriate" golf, tennis and fitness attire is permitted in The Grille.

Cell Phone Policy

The use of cellular telephones and other electronic devices to send, receive or listen to audible messages is not permitted on Club premises, except the parking lot and in the phone booth located in the men's locker room.

Sending, receiving or reading visual and/or written messages from electronic devices, such as cellular phones, computers, tablets, watches and the like is permitted if used in silent mode and no sound is emitted from any such device.

Social Media

Eldorado Country Club understands that many participate in social networking sites (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, SnapChat and LinkedIn) as well as participate in chat rooms, and create and maintain personal websites, including blogs. The Club respects your online social networking and personal internet use. Please be mindful to use electronic media responsibly and to be respectful of the privacy of others. To protect our entire membership's privacy, Eldorado does not encourage the public posting of any photos taken on Eldorado grounds by members or their guests. Any member who does not wish for their photo, a family member's (including those under the age of 18) or guest's photo to be published on the Club's private website photo gallery, (login and password required) must notify the Club's administration in writing.
