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


Every Summer, the ECOA staff diligently completes

ECOA Welomes Recycling!

The ECOA values the importance of recycling and appreciates everyone's participation in this collective effort. We are implementing a system that benefits all. The Patio attendants will collect recycling daily.

Here's How the Recycling Process Will Function:

- Each cottage will need a dedicated trash container solely for recycling purposes.
- The container needs to be placed outside, like the rest of the trash containers, for easy access by Patio Staff.
- · Oversized items are not permitted for recycling.
- Cans and bottles must be securely bagged to avoid contaminating the cardboard.
- Any cardboard boxes must be broken down.
 (The Patio Staff will be responsible for breaking down cardboard)
- Desert Arc will not accept any wax-coated or dirty cardboard.
- The ECOA will provide the recycling container to those cottages that don't have one.

We have a variety of top newspapers available, including the Desert Sun, Los Angeles Times, New York Times, New York Post, and the Wall Street Journal. To ensure you receive the publications you desire during your stay, please contact Kirsten Stump at cottagereservations@eldoradocc.org or (760)423.1581.

Kirsten will need your in-house dates to get your desired newspapers into circulation. Please note that our newspaper vendors have recently changed their ordering procedures, and we now need to place our order weekly on Wednesdays by noon. This means we will need a week's advance notice if you wish to register for newspaper delivery or stop your newspaper service. If you have any questions about this change, please don't hesitate to contact us.

Eldorado Security also delivers all cottage mail and packages.

Trash Pick-Up, Window Washing, and Patio Cleaning

Keeping the environment clean and tidy is essential for a comfortable living experience. That's why we ensure that trash bins are emptied daily, with the staff picking them up at noon. We also provide monthly exterior window washing from November through May, with an initial interior cleaning at the beginning of the season. Moreover, we offer weekly patio cleaning that starts on the day you arrive. Let us take care of the cleanliness so that you can focus on enjoying your stay to the fullest.

Pest Control

Fernando's Bust-a-Bug provides bi-annual interior spraying for all cottages and monthly exterior spraying to prevent pests. If you need any more services, we can make arrangements for you.

Supplies

Most cottage owners prefer to bring their own cleaning supplies and paper products, but for those who don't, ECOA offers a convenient service at a fee of \$365 per calendar year, billed to your cottage account in January. The paper products will be delivered and stocked according to protocol. Cleaning and disinfecting products will be kept on the housekeeping carts. ECOA's housekeepers are trained in the optimal use of these products and will use them accordingly.





HVAC Maintenance

DMD Mechanical is our go-to vendor for HVAC maintenance. The standard fee for each system is \$89. However, please note that extra charges may be applicable for high-efficiency media and electronic filters. Any expenses incurred will be added to the cottage owners' account.

Important To Know

Architectural Dates of Submission

If you're planning to do a construction or renovation project anytime soon, please submit your preliminary plans to the Cottage Services office for review by the Architectural Committee. You can do this between November 1, 2024, and March 1, 2025. Final working drawings should be submitted before April 1, 2025. Construction season runs from May 1 through November 15 each year. <u>Any construction work NOT completed by the end of business day November 15 will result in construction overrun charges</u>.




